January 18, 2023**

**OLD BUSINESS:**

- Capital Campaign Update:
  - American Roofing has been great to work with. They have a plan to move forward with the leaks.
  - Fr. Tony talked about the altar and showed us what it will look like. Universal Design stated they are 6-9 months out from last November, so the possibility of starting could be October 10th whenever Fr. Tony gets back from his sabbatical.
- My Parish App- Not enough info just yet.
- Quad Parish Update- Fr. said that they have had a couple meetings already.
- Quilt Social- The Parish Council is going to host the next one on January 22nd. Derek is going to send out an email on what people can bring.
- St. Paul Decals/Ornaments- Mary K is still trying to get a design worked out for the decals. She will update us at a later date.
- Beer & Brats- Derek talked about the outcome from this event. He said that everyone who came really enjoyed it. He was going to make a list of things that he thought could have been done differently, and how they would need more volunteers to do it again in the future.
  - The idea of having something like this done at a place other than the church. The idea of having something going on at The Hall, or on the Pour Haus Patio. We could have an event the weekend after Fr. Tony gets back in October.
- Cooking with Fr. Kolbe- This was an idea that was brought up. It would be something fun to do in the parish hall for couples or whomever wants to participate.
- 50th Anniversary Mass- The turnout was wonderful, and the event was very appreciated.

- Outreach Center- There is a new roof on the building. There is 40K invested now for that building over there, and we would like to get 250K.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

- We would like to have another meeting before Fr. Tony leaves for his sabbatical.

He is planning on leaving April 10th and will return October 10th.

-Fr. Kolbe is going to cover everything while Fr. Tony is gone- he is the sacramental administrator.

-Fr. Steve Ginini? With St. Francis Sinclair is going to be the overseer/take over administration when Fr. is gone.

-Mandy is going to be the ground administrator.

-Bernie Bower will also be in contact with Fr. Tony weekly.

- Consecration of the Holy Family- Derek will follow-up at the next meeting.
- Parish Picnic- The picnic committee is going to be having a meeting on January 30th. Chad will have more updates at the next meeting.
- Inactive Parish Members- Derek had some good points about the inactive members in our parish, how can we get them to return to the parish? What are the inactive members wanting out of the church? We can get a hold of them and let them know what has changed and that they are invited to come back and see how the church has changed. It would be beneficial to make up a calling committee of individuals that would be great making phone calls to these members.
- House of Worship Training- Fr. Tony talked about this and the safety class that is going to be taking place at St. Meinrad on February 7th. He would like to see at least 3 representatives from St. Paul go.
- Code of Conduct- Safe Parish training for adults. The certification is good for 5 years. It is an online training program that he would like us to have done by March 1st.
- Canon Law- Fr. Tony discussed this with us.
- Directory- It will have all 4 parishes in the same directory. All 4 of the parishes are going to come to St. Paul. There are times you can sign up online or before masses.

**Commission Reports:** Mandy went over the report handout. Does not have December's report done yet. She also discussed switching the envelope collection company.
