Every person 14 years of age or older must abstain from meat (and items made with meat) on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and every Friday of Lent. Every person between the ages of 18 and 59 (your 18th birthday completes your 18th year, and your 59th birthday begins your 60th year) must fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting consists of one full meal per day, with two smaller meals that do not add up to a full meal, and no snacks.

Every person 14 years of age or older must abstain from meat on all other Fridays of the year unless he or she substitutes some other form of penance for Abstinence.
