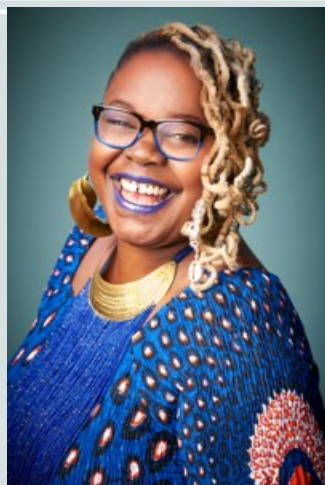


Rev. Aisha Brooks-Lytle,
