

Session Action

At the most recent Session meeting on August 25, upon recommendation of the Reopening Task Force, the Session took the following actions:

- ◆ For those who are comfortable returning to worship in the Sanctuary, we will begin live worship at 9:30 a.m. on Sunday, September 20 if the following criteria are met
 1. a rolling 14 day average of new cases below 50 per day, using the Naples Community Hospital data, and
 2. a rolling 14 day average of less than 10% positivity rate, using the Naples Community Hospital data.
- ◆ For those who choose not to return to live worship, we will continue recording a worship service on Saturdays. It will be made available online and sent by e-mail early Sunday mornings.
- ◆ Church meetings and groups will continue to be held via Zoom through September.

The following guidelines have been established for the health and safety of our worshippers:

- ◆ Bring an open heart, mind and spirit
- ◆ Masks will be required
- ◆ Maintain social distancing of 6 feet apart
- ◆ There will be three entrance/exit doors available: 1. off the west parking lot, 2. through the Narthex on 6th Street, and 3. at the corner of 6th Street S and 3rd Avenue S (circular drive thru)
- ◆ Ushers will seat you and the congregation will be dismissed by row following worship
- ◆ Pew rows will be marked to maintain social distancing
- ◆ Specified seating will be available for families and those with disabilities
- ◆ There will be no congregational singing, however, we will enjoy the choir soloists
- ◆ Bulletins will be available on the pews and can be taken home or placed in the bins at the exits
- ◆ The balconies, elevator, Spencer Hall and the Wiggle Room will be closed
- ◆ Offering plates will not be passed, instead donation boxes will be available at the entrance/exit doors, or you can donate via mail or online
- ◆ Restrooms will be open however, please limit to 2 people at a time
