

Typical day for one of our Volunteers

When you arrive locate the volunteer check-in station

Sign-in

Turn in waiver form/complete waiver form

Make a name tag

Site leader will give you a brief orientation, safety talk, and will describe the tasks for the day.

When you Leave

Notify a staff member that you are leaving

Sign-out

Frequently Asked Questions

After I submit my on-line registration form and view the orientation, what is next?

You should select from any of the volunteer opportunities from our online volunteer calendar, or call the Volunteer Coordinator.

Do I have to register with Central SC Habitat for Humanity prior to going to the volunteer site?

Yes, either online or at a volunteer orientation in person.

Do I have to stay on site all day?

We prefer to have volunteers stay all day, but it's not required. If you are unable to stay all day, let your site lead know as soon as you check in.

Do I have to be there at the start of the scheduled shift?

Yes. When we start a shift at the build site or ReStore, your site leader will conduct a safety talk and hand out job assignments. If you are not there first thing in the morning, you will not be familiar with what is going on and all of the volunteer jobs may be filled.

What should I leave at home?

Jewelry (it can get damaged or lost easily), children under the age of 16, and pets.

Do I have to have previous construction experience?

No. There are skilled individuals on site who will lead you in construction tasks.

Who should I look for when I arrive on site?

Check in with any member of our site team when you arrive. Individuals on our site team should be wearing an HFH baseball cap or t-shirt.
