Age Restrictions

| <p>All construction volunteers must be age 16 or older to assist on an Central SC Habitat for Humanity construction site.</p> <p>One adult supervisor should accompany every five youth volunteers (ages 16-17).</p> <p>Certain activities are restricted for volunteers under the age of 18. Including, but not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No ladders or scaffolding • No power tools <p>Accompanying adults are responsible for assuring all youth follow construction site and age restriction policies.</p> <p>When we have youth-friendly days on the build site (painting, landscaping) it will be posted on the volunteer calendar.</p> | <p>All ReStore volunteers must be age 14 or older to assist in the ReStore.</p> <p>One adult supervisor should accompany every five youth volunteers (ages 14-17).</p> <p>Certain activities are restricted for volunteers under the age of 18. These include but are not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No ladders • No power tools or power equipment <p>Accompanying adults are responsible for assuring all youth follow ReStore and age restriction policies.</p> |

What to Wear

| <i>Build sites are active in the spring, early summer, fall, and winter. Work is mostly outside until the later part of the build.</i> | <i>Not all processing areas of the ReStore are temperature controlled so heat/cool area may depend on the time of year.</i> |
| <p>Closed toed tennis shoes or boots are required <i>(no crocs or sandals)</i></p> <p>Clothes you don't mind getting dirty are strongly encouraged. For cooler weather, layered clothing is suggested For summer, shorts are ok, but not booty shorts or short shorts</p> <p>Jewelry is not recommended, because it can get damaged or lost very easily</p> <p>Please remember that Habitat is a faith-based organization so please do not wear anything featuring offensive or explicit language, images, etc.</p> | |
