



A statement from Fr. Steven H. Breck, Pastor...

St. Mary Magdalene just concluded our 30th Annual Homecoming Festival. We are very grateful to those who worked tirelessly to put on a fun and successful event – we could not have done it without our committee, volunteers, sponsors, and patrons.

On Sunday evening of the last night of St. Mary Magdalene's annual parish festival, there was an influx of people that caused the attendance numbers to be much higher than anticipated. We are unaware of any reports of any gun being discharged or of any injuries to anyone. The parish festival is intended to be a family-friendly, uplifting event and we are saddened that the unruly behavior of some caused distress to any of those attending Sunday evening.
