

## Minutes -OUTREACH BOARD- September 24, 2019

In attendance: Rose Dahill, Maryann Darzano, Liz Halbert, Tink Shelton, Ruth Smith and Cathie Courtnage

After the opening prayer by Maryann, the minutes were approved.

Ruth announced the resignation of Carolyn Zarbock from the board. We will be looking for new members for the Outreach Board.

There was a discussion about the Outreach budget and it was suggested to ask Bob Fuchs to attend the next meeting to clarify some areas. We would also like Deacon Sally's input as to the progress with the homeless housing initiative.

### **Ministry Reports:**

**Mens Club:** Ruth reported that the men would like donations made from the current budget to the following areas: the Food Pantry, the Sheriff's Anchor Initiative and to New Hope Clinic. The Frogmore Stew picnic was held today. The Men's breakfast will be on September 29th following the 8:00 service.

**ECW:** Tink announced that the program from A Safe Place will be October 17th at 7pm. She also said the the next ECW luncheon will be October 31st at the Kokocabana Restaurant on the new pier. ECW will sponsor the UTO (United Thank Offering) beginning with the distribution of boxes on November 3rd and concluding on December 1st.

Tink reported that the ECW board suggested the following areas for donations from the current budget: Episcopal Relief and Development (ERD) for hurricane relief to both the Outer Banks and the Bahamas. The ECW board would also like to see the Fall Festival funds distributed in the following way: 1/3 to the Homeless Housing Initiative, 1/3 to the Capital Campaign and 1/3 to ERD.

**Diaper Ministry:** Maryann announced a diaper wrapping meeting on October 10th from 12-4pm.

The Outreach Board agreed to the following for distribution of all funds from the Outreach Endowment Fund (formerly the Mission Fund):

- \$1000 - Episcopal Relief and Development for hurricane relief for the Bahamas
- \$1000 - Outer Banks Community Foundation for hurricane relief for the Outer Banks of North Carolina
- \$601 - Daughters of the King Master Fund to help with education for women interested in studying in religious related fields

Ruth reminded us of the ongoing Stewardship Drive. We will continue our discussions about funds distribution at our next meeting on **October 29th at 2:30.**
