

Minutes - OUTREACH BOARD - March 10, 2020

In attendance: Frazer Crane, Maryann Darzano, Peter del Sol, Kristine Holt, Shirley Desnoyers, Jane Mitchell, Ruth Smith, Cathie Courtnage

The meeting began with a prayer by Ruth Smith after which the minutes from December 2019 were approved.

Kristine Holt and Jane Mitchell were welcomed as new members of the board. Glenn Kinsberg is resigning from the Outreach board, so we will need to look for a replacement to serve with Kristine on SOICF.

The current financial report was reviewed and discussed by those present. Ruth reminded us that Outreach receives \$1250 quarterly from the church budget. At this time our balance is \$2,722.17.

Ministry Reports:

Men's Club: Preparations are being made for the upcoming Lobster Sale. It was emphasized that this is a popular event within the community and brings in @\$6,000.

Winter Shelter: Ruth reviewed parts of Ida Parker's thank you letter to the parish that stated that costs and the number of rooms have increased. There was great participation from the parish.

Monday Lunches: It was reported that over 1800 meals were served over 47 Mondays.

Diaper Ministry: The current balance is \$3,852. Maryann reported that 17 people helped at the latest wrapping party.

ECW: Jane will be replacing Tink. Jane reported that the monthly Lunch Bunch get togethers are going well. She reminded us of the Spiritual Day on April 25th at St. Philip's and the ECW Annual Meeting at St. Paul's in Wilmington on April 22nd. She shared a concern about how construction of the new Parish Hall might affect the Fall Festival in October.

Belize Mission: Shirley gave an overview of this mission as to where the donations come from and financial requirements for shipping the school materials to Belize. She requested \$2000 for the shipping costs to be donated by the end of August. This request was approved by the board.

New Business: Ruth shared thank you notes that had been received for donations. Peter shared a concern about storage of the altar and church service materials for the summer beach services. Accommodations for visiting beach service priests are also being explored.

The board has decided to meet quarterly and our next meeting will be **June 9th at 2:30.**
