Confirmed approval of February minutes.

- Fr. Eric spoke to Dennis Courtage about the medical issue that occurred at church last week. Fr. Eric asked that in the future, the altar party (priest or deacon) be notified if the situation will be handled internally, or if outside medical services are coming. This will allow the clergy to plan.
- Word from the National Church wrt Corona Virus : 3 recommendations: 1. Wash hands often 2. Clergy should use hand sanitizer before communion distribution and 3. Communicants should not intinct the host, drink from chalice instead.  
Fr. Eric will inform the parish of these recommendations.
