April Minutes approved and confirmed

- The Board voted and unanimously approved moving the ministry to Carillon Retirement Home back to the Worship Ministry Board. This ministry is represented on the board by Loraine Armstrong. - The new wax candles (Paschal and Aumbry) are working well. The Aumbry candles are lasting for the week as planned.
- A brief review of Holy Week followed with the overall impression that it went very well. Fr. Eric thanked the ministries for their hard work to make the week a success. Many positive comments about Tenebrae and the Triduum were received by board members.
- The service at Brunswick Town is scheduled for May 19. It will be posted in the announcements and ENews to remind parishioners to bring chairs and bug spray. The portable altar used at the beach ministry will be used at Brunswick town as well.
- The Celebration of New Ministry is scheduled for May 22 at 6:00 PM. Ushers, readers and eucharistic ministers have been scheduled. Items to remember: reserved seating for visiting clergy, table for “gifts” presented to Fr. Eric.
- June’s schedule is ‘normal’ with the addition of the Beach service.
- Loraine Armstrong met with Fr. Eric to discuss the Carillon Ministry. There is a need to get Worship Leaders trained and licensed to be in compliance with diocesan rules.
- The new handheld mic is working well. Thank you to Ricky and Jeff Krantz for getting that connected to our current system. Current system may need to be replaced in the not too distant future.
- Lorraine Beamer thanked Bobbie Fuchs for her continued support with the scheduling.
- Fr Eric asked that ushers tell the priests (while they are receiving communion) if there are parishioners who need communion brought to them. The priest and chalice bearer will then follow the usher to the individual(s) who are in need. If ushers wait till after they receive communion to tell the priest, the priest often times does not notice.
