- Schedule of Christmas services at St. Philip’s submitted to Janet Fox for publication
- Discussion regarding the hanging of flags once work is completed in Chapel of the Cross. An anonymous donor has agreed to fund the purchase. Ricky will contact the local Southport historian as to what flags were raised when the COC was built. Deacon Pam will do some research on her own including looking for pictures from the past before they were removed. If the decision is made to hang the flags again, the confederate flag will not be hung. All agreed to “wait and see” once all information is collected and renovations are complete.
- Altar Guild will decide on placement of Nativity scene in the sanctuary
- Dennis mentioned some feedback has been given by the head ushers regarding the removal of the table in the back of the church. Extra collection plates to be placed under the table in Narthex where the table will remain. A new security protocol will be introduced. Ushers will need to attend one of two training sessions towards end of Jan. regarding the new procedures.
- Peter has recruited additional help with beach services in the event he cannot attend. Mick Tomac, Steve Russell and Maitland Barnes have agreed to assist. Fr Eric has asked for a meeting of the group to discuss beach ministry duties and future storage of altar.
- Lorraine mentioned a very serious need for more LEV’s and LEM’s. There is not enough supply of volunteers to only be able to serve once a month. Current volunteers should pass the word.
- Wreaths will be placed on exterior doors and greening of the church will be 12/22 at 2PM.
