- Confirmed approval of September minutes
- Janet Fox attended the meeting to introduce herself as St. Philip’s liaison to State Port Pilot as well as heading up and communicating interesting and noteworthy events to the community. - Discussion of the gift of the frontal presented to St. Philip’s. It was stated that it could not be altered to fit the Chapel of the Cross altar. The frontal will be used during the season of Epiphany in the main Sanctuary. Verbiage for future gifting policy will be submitted and added to current one in place as ministries should be responsible in decision making on the acceptance of items.

- Jan would like to change the charge for funeral flowers to \$150 (from \$175)

- Flags have been offered for donation by a parishioner once Chapel of the Cross renovation is complete.
