May minutes approval confirmed

- May services, of which there were many, went very smoothly
- Discussion of letter received from parishioner regarding lack of flowers at Brunswicktown in addition to observation of elements laying on ground. Ricky stated that elements were on top of the box where they had always previously been placed and were never “on the ground”. Jan addressed the absence of flowers. Flower guild co-leaders decided as a group not to set up flowers (which has occurred in years past). Proportion scale, placement, transportation factored in decision. Going forward, flower sign-up should designate donation will be for 8AM service only and not 10:30 @ Brunswicktown.

Fr. Eric thought that an appropriate statement should read:

“In lieu of flowers, we will enjoy the beauty of God’s creation”
