June minutes approval confirmed

- Ricky called parishioner regarding letter sent to Worship Board. All good.
- New Usher customary presented. Still need to finish up regarding the “medical concerns” section. Will keep what is currently written until the Church Security team offers their findings with suggestions. Dennis would like to have an usher training (date TBD).
- Jan said there was a new minimum for ordering flowers and that the current refrigerator does not have the capacity to hold them. Debbie suggested that they look at the one currently in Carr Jorgensen to see if that will suffice.
- Two parishioners proposed making crosses out of the old nails that are being discarded from Chapel of the Cross, proceeds would be donated to its restoration. This has been deferred to Finance and Facilities board as it will be a fund raiser for St. Philip’s and not part of Worship.
- Discussion regarding a gift presented to Altar Guild. A group of parishioners funded and presented a handmade chasuble and stole to Fr. Eric. With leftover material, a frontal, burse cover and pulpit hangings were also made. The Altar Guild currently has two complete sets of green altar coverings. It was suggested that the new frontal might be altered to use in Chapel of the Cross. Ricky will call the seamstress and see if this would be OK.
- Jacob Beamer offered to do a Jazz Mass which would have to be performed by end of Aug. at a cost of \$300 to the musicians. Debbie stated that the music for August has already been set up. Suggestion deferred until there is more time for planning.
- Beach Ministry visiting supply priests had a low response this year. Jimmy and May Moore had offered accommodations in years past in a separate apartment they had in their house. Is there any way to offer an incentive for those that travel? Discussions to follow for planning next year’s services.
