**Genuflexion** – A momentary kneeling on the right knee with the body erect used as a ceremonial reverence when passing before the Blessed Sacrament, or before the unveiled cross on Good Friday and formerly at the *incarnatus*\* in the Nicene Creed and on certain other occasions. Until 1967, a double genuflexion, made by kneeling on both knees and bowing the head, was used before the Blessed Sacrament exposed. At St. Philip's you will often see bowing as a sign of reverence.

\*Latin term translated into English as Incarnation. It refers to the christological assertion that Jesus was fully human and fully divine, the Son of God or Word in the flesh. The specific term Incarnatus refers to the assertion in the Nicene Creed that Jesus "became incarnate from the Virgin Mary and was made man" (BCP, p. 358).
