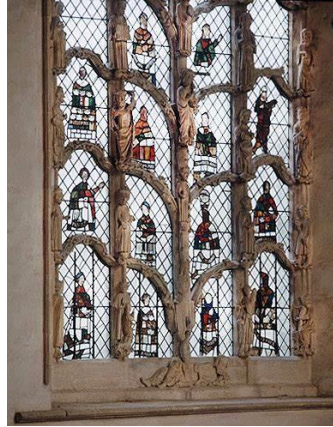




Jesse Window: A window whose design is based on the descent of Jesus from the royal line of David. It usually takes the form of a tree springing from Jesse, the father of David, and ending in Jesus or the Virgin and Holy Child. The intermediary descendants are placed on scrolls of foliage branching out from each other. Examples of the window are to be seen at the cathedrals of Wells and Chartres, St. George's, Hanover Square, and in Dorchester Abbey, near Oxford as seen below.
