# Redbird 2023 Mission Trip Modified Plan

**After much prayerful consideration, a decision has been made to modify the April 2023 Red Bird Mission Trip as originally planned.**

**The primary rationale and considerations were that of the health and safety of the Missioners who would sign up to participate.**

The current Red Bird Work Camp protocols and our history of Missioner sickness, i.e., colds, flu, etc. on mission trips create a likely situation that could require our team to return home prematurely in order to minimize the health and safety of other work camp and community members.

The concept of ride, sleep, eat and work together has its limitations. Large groups of Missioners in close confined quarters can result in increased health risks.

**Even though St. Paul UMC will not be sending a large team of Missioners in April 2023; smaller individual Missioner teams are encouraged. Smaller Missioner teams can make their own arrangements with Red Bird. Mayo Collier will assist you with contact information.**

**Some project examples for individual Missioners or Sunday School classes to consider:**

1. Collection and delivery of pots and pans to be given to families whose home has been destroyed by fire.
2. Volunteer as an individual to do electrical work.
3. Volunteer to work at the community store, the lumber yard, kitchen, food pantry etc.
4. Volunteer to teach Bible study at the school by Missioner Michael Grady.
5. Prepare and deliver backpacks with school supplies or send requested school supplies.
6. Collection and delivery of medical supplies by Missioner Jamie Guy of Mcleod Hospital.
7. Organize and conduct local Mission work or service projects.

**The objective here is to try to maximize St. Paul UMC and Missioner involvement and participation in these projects.**
