Holy Week and Adoration Chapel – Holy Thursday to Easter Vigil Holy Week is the Church's most special prayer season beginning with the Mass of the Lord's Supper on **Holy Thursday** (March 29th) at 7:00 p.m. followed with the Passion of the Lord on **Good Friday** at 3:00 p.m. (March 30th), and concluding with the **Easter Vigil** at 8:00 p.m. on Holy Saturday (March 31st). These are special days of prayer for the whole church but also for us individually.

The presence of the adoration chapel provides an additional opportunity for individual prayer. The adoration chapel will be open **all day and all night** after the Holy Thursday service until the Easter Vigil at 8:00 p.m. on Saturday with the exception of the Good Friday prayer at 3:00 p.m. when we gather to pray as a community.

It would be especially helpful if you could **sign up** for Thursday evening, Friday, and Saturday in the chapel, or on the parish web site (www.hanb.org), or by calling the Parish Center ([262-786-7330](tel:262-786-7330)).

As we prepare for Holy Week, please note that there will not be evening activities next week. All after-school activities, including ASIP, peer mentoring, and Geo Cache Club, will continue as scheduled. Thank you!

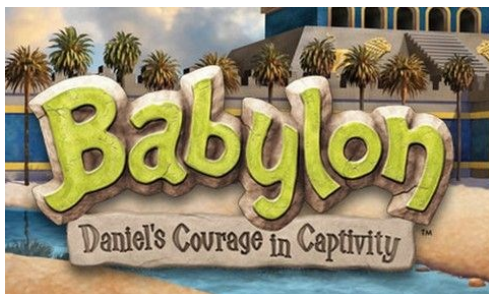
