



3K Frequently Asked Questions

In the Holy Apostles 3K program, we follow the Wisconsin Model Early Learning Standards (WMELS) as a guide for our curriculum. WMELS is divided into domains including: Health and Physical Development; Social and Emotional Development; Language Development and Communication; Approaches to Learning; Cognition and General Knowledge; and Faith Development. We recognize that each child is an individual and therefore develops and masters skills at a their own rate. We identify where your child is and set goals for them to help them develop skills in each of these areas and therefore move further along the continuum. Formal assessments in the form of the Archdiocesan Early Childhood Developmental Action Plan will be shared with parents twice a year, along with an in-person conference in the fall.

DOES MY CHILD NEED TO BE POTTY TRAINED? Yes, every child must be potty-trained to attend our 3K program.

CAN MY CHILD TAKE THE BUS? No, the bus company sets the regulations for this. Parents or guardians must drop off and pick up their child.

ARE THERE ANY ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS FOR MY CHILD TO START THE PROGRAM? No, we have no academic requirements. For most children, this is their first school experience. Our focus is on creating a safe and loving environment so that your child will grow and learn at his or her own pace.

CAN MY CHILD TAKE HOT LUNCH? No, but they may purchase milk.

HOW CAN I FIND OUT MORE INFORMATION ABOUT WRAP-AROUND CARE AND EXTENDED CARE? Please go to our website hanschool.org and click on Parent Resources.

WHAT IS THE SCHEDULE DURING WRAP-AROUND CARE? From 7:30 a.m. – 8:30 a.m. our teacher allows free-choice play or will work with students on projects and activities planned for that day. From 11:30 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. students eat their lunches in the classroom followed by rest time. If time permits, after rest time students can play and then it's time to go home.
