ADULT CLASSES

Acts Class (Room 2207) Teacher: Carol McCann
This class uses the lectionary based curriculum, *Seasons of the Spirit* and includes those adults who are interested in a discussion class for biblical awareness in present times.

Encountering the Bible (Room 2211) Teacher: Rich West
Using a variety of methods and sources, this class takes an informative look at Scripture in its original context and in modern scholarship, engages in discussion to discover what God's message is in contemporary life, and encourages participants to live out their faith in new ways. This year the class will be working its way through Corinthians, Romans, Ephesians, Philippians, and Colossians.

Julian Lake (Conference Room) Teachers: Clarkson McDow and Bob Moss.

This class uses the *Feasting on the Word* Curriculum which connects worship and faith formation, engaging adults in a deeper exploration of biblical texts. Participants' faith will be enhanced when the Scriptures read and proclaimed in worship are reinforced and expanded during the Sunday school hour.

The Watering Hole (Presbyterian Students Center)

This discussion class focuses on one of the lectionary readings for the week with an emphasis on how it ties into our lives today. What is the lectionary? The Revised Common Lectionary is a three-year cycle of weekly scripture readings used to varying degrees by the vast majority of mainline Protestant churches in Canada and the United States. It is built around the seasons of the Church Year. During most of the year, the readings are a reading from the Hebrew Bible, a Psalm, a reading from the Epistles, and a Gospel reading.

Mindfulness and Meditation Class (2209)

We gather, read a quote from a Christian teacher or mystic (like Mother Teresa or Brother Lawrence), meditate together, and discuss. No experience necessary, all are welcome.
