### **ST GABRIEL SOUP KITCHEN VOLUNTEERS:**

On the weekend of Jan 18-19 and 25-26 we will be signing up new volunteers to help with the St Gabriels service at the JOY Soup Kitchen. Please consider joining us – talk to one of the volunteers who will be in the atrium after mass and have them explain what is involved. As a volunteer you will be part of a team which is responsible for bringing food to the kitchen once every two months. The food provided includes soups, sandwiches, salads, cooked vegetables. You will be asked to prepare only one item and take it to the kitchen on the Friday morning. The team captain will call you before the day, remind you of the task and organize the menu. For many years the parish has supplied food to the soup kitchen – in fact the kitchen was started at St Gabriels over 30 years ago.
