PARISH REGISTRATION

If you are new to our parish, you are encouraged to register as soon as possible. Registration in a parish is the norm and is required for registration in religious education, for sacramental preparation, and for sponsorship certificates. Registration forms are available in the parish office, or the ministry table in the atrium.

BAPTISM: The celebration of Baptism is a moment of grace for those to be Baptized, for their families, as well as for the entire parish community. Please contact Sister Angie to register for preparation classes.

FAITH FORMATION: All children not attending Catholic school should be enrolled in our Faith Formation Program. For more information, please contact Sister Angie.

R.C.I.A.: Adults who would like to learn more about the Catholic Faith or wish to become Catholic should consider enrolling in R.C.I.A. classes. Interested persons should contact Sister Angie.

MARRIAGE: Couples planning to be married must see a priest at least six months prior to the planned marriage. Pre-marriage instruction is required. Please do not set a date in advance until you have spoken to the pastor.

ST GABRIEL SOUP KITCHEN VOLUNTEERS:

On the weekend of Jan 18-19 and 25-26 we will be signing up new volunteers to help with the St Gabriels service at the JOY Soup Kitchen. Please consider joining us – talk to one of the volunteers who will be in the atrium after mass and have them explain what is involved. As a volunteer you will be part of a team which is responsible for bringing food to the kitchen once every two months. The food provided includes soups, sandwiches, salads, cooked vegetables. You will be asked to prepare only one item and take it to the kitchen on the Friday morning. The team captain will call you before the day, remind you of the task and organize the menu. For many years the parish has supplied food to the soup kitchen – in fact the kitchen was started at St Gabriels over 30 years ago. Today it operates as an independent agency located at 700 Albermarle Avenue; we are one of many church groups in the area that take responsibility for bringing food once or twice a month.
