### Schedule for the reopening of our church:

**Saturday:** Vigil Mass in English at 5:00 p.m., and in Spanish at 7:00 p.m.

**Sundays:** English at 9:30 a.m., and Spanish at 12:30 p.m.

**Sunday Masses will be livestreamed via Facebook for those who cannot attend.**

The obligation to attend Sunday Mass continues to be waived by the Bishop of the Diocese of Raleigh. **If you come to vigil Mass, you fulfill your Sunday obligation.** Please be aware of the guidelines for people at high risk according to the NC Department of Health and Human Services (NCDHHS), and follow the ones listed below. **Confessions in the chapel: Saturday at 3:00 p.m. or by appointment. Please wear a mask.**

#### ATTENDEES TO MASS MUST...

- Come with a joyful, nice, and respectful disposition
- Be at church no **later than 10 minutes before Mass begins**
- Come into the church using only the front door that will be open
- Kindly follow the instructions of the ushers
- Wear a mask at all times while on campus and during Mass, properly **covering nose and mouth**
- Remain 6 feet apart (unless members of the same household)
- Bring their own sanitizer and wipes to **disinfect chairs before and after each use**
- Please practice the three Ws: wear a mask, wash your hands and wait to keep social distance

#### DURING MASS:

- No physical sign of peace
- No communal songs/brochures
- No passing of collection baskets
- No congregating before and after Mass
- **Please do not sing:** be comfortable just praying in silence with the hymns

- Eucharistic Ministers will wear a mask
- **You are asked to receive the Eucharist ONLY in the hand**
- Attendees will remain in their area and Eucharistic Ministers will come to them
- When Mass ends, please follow the instructions of the ushers and leave the building using the same door you used to get in: again, the door will be open

#### PLEASE REMAIN HOME IF...

- You are immunocompromised
- You feel sick or have problems with breathing/coughing
- You suspect you may have been exposed to COVID-19
- You have a sick family member at home
- You feel anxious and fearful about public events
- You want to be cautious about the official guidelines on the NCDHHS website
- You do not feel comfortable wearing a mask
- **RESTROOMS IN THE CHURCH WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR USE IF YOU HAVE YOUR OWN SANITIZER AND WIPES FOR DISINFECTION.**
