Empty Nesters

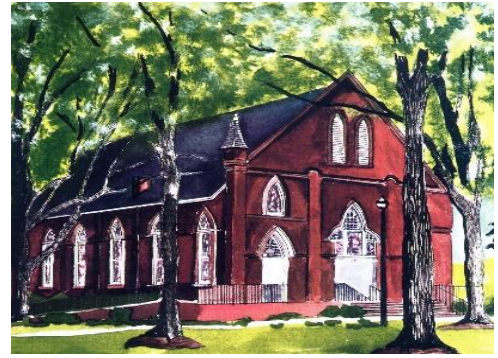
