## CLASS STRUCTURES

The "Creative Curriculum" is our base curriculum using a "Learning through Play" philosophy. This curriculum is enhanced by our excellent, experienced and educated teachers and spiritual enrichment through worship music and chapel lessons.

### TODDLER CLASS (10:2 RATIO)

In a safe and loving environment full of play and learning among peers, Toddlers will begin to learn how to follow simple instructions and broaden their knowledge through play.

### TWO YEAR OLDS (12:2 RATIO)

At this age, children are "sponges", so we provide a wealth of sensory experiences for them to absorb. These students learn naming colors, shapes and numbers, as well as, how to utilize reasoning and listening skills. We emphasize social interaction and shared experiences in a loose structure.

### THREE YEAR OLDS (14:2 RATIO)

This class works on developing independence through dressing, eating and healthy restroom habits and cooperative living skills, such as, taking turns, sharing and listening to others. We work on improving gross motor skills through play, games and outdoor activities. Students enjoy art and sensory tables that develop fine motor skills.

### FOUR YEAR OLDS (8:1 RATIO)

The emphasis here is school readiness, while developing confidence, problem solving and communication skills to properly name and express emotions. Activities in this classroom are designed to enhance visual motor, fine motor and gross motor skills. Students learn to develop their language and listening skills, as well.

### TRANSITIONAL KINDERGARTEN (8:1 RATIO)

In this program, the emphasis is on school readiness through a hands-on, child-centered reading, writing, math, and science program utilizing *Alpha Time*, *Success in Reading and Writing*, *Handwriting Without Tears*, *Math Their Way* and *Weekly Reader*. Children are actively involved in doing, creating, thinking and experimenting, while learning valuable social skills.
