We will collect our **Mother's Day Offering** next Sunday, May 12th during Worship Service.

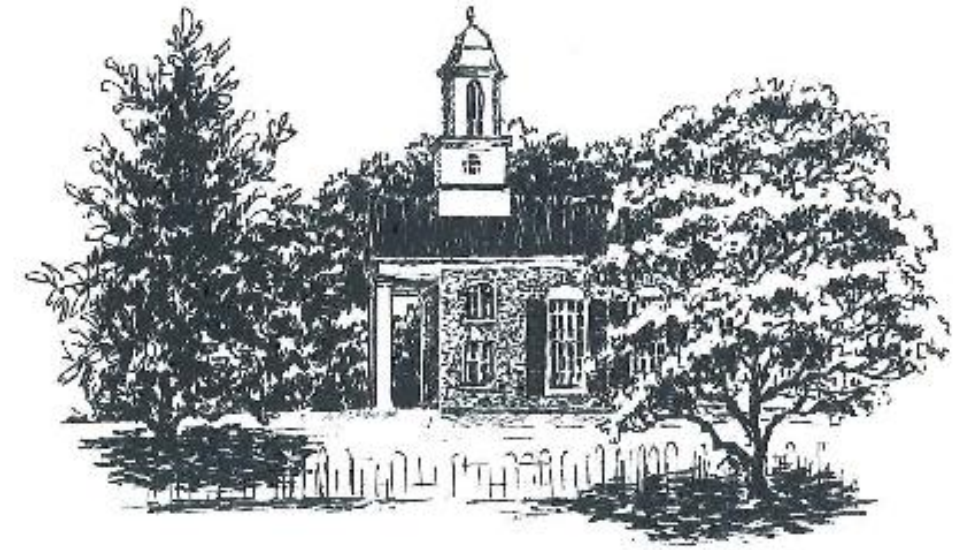
