Deposit: \$100.00 by Mar. 16th

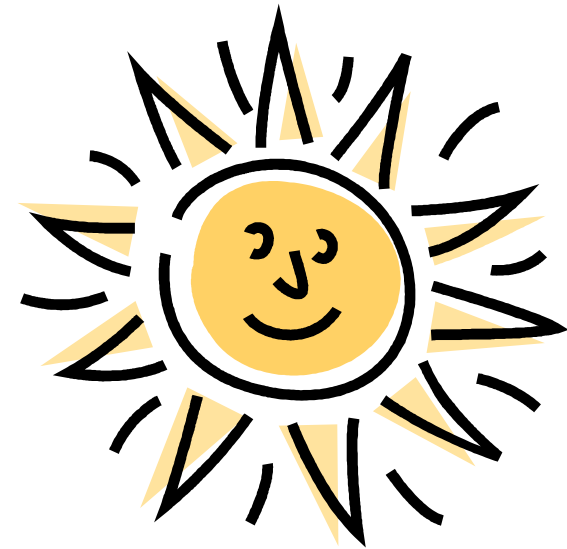
Final payment due: \$300.00 by June 1st

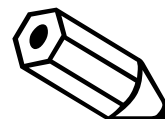
Registrations for trips must have a deposit payment accompanying the form.
