### 3. Rector's Reflections.

- e. The Rev. Kirchmier reminded the vestry that she will be on vacation September 2-16, 2021.
- 4. A motion was made and seconded to approve the July 22, 2021 vestry meeting minutes. The motion carried.
- 5. All financial obligations are current, all July bills have been paid, and the St. Andrew's Church Operating Checking Fund balance was \$72,215.48 at the end of July. The following account balances were current at the end of July:
