I remember sitting with my mom several days before her death. She was being cared for at her home with hospice assisting. I had sensed that something was on her mind troubling her, and I assumed she was afraid of what would happen when she died. I thought perhaps she has questions about her belief in heaven, hell, and her belief in purgatory (that limbo between being with God and God being temporarily absent). As it turned out, my mom was troubled because she didn't know about the "process" of dying and what her body would experience. When the hospice nurse talked with her about this, she was very relieved. I said to her, "I thought you were worried about what would happen when you die" and she said, "Oh no, I am going to heaven". My mom had her faith and that gave her the comfort she needed. When Pastor Lowell spoke those words..."Be Not Afraid...Christ Will Bring Us Home", I smiled and remembered my mom and her strong faith and that she was, in fact, HOME. AMEN.
