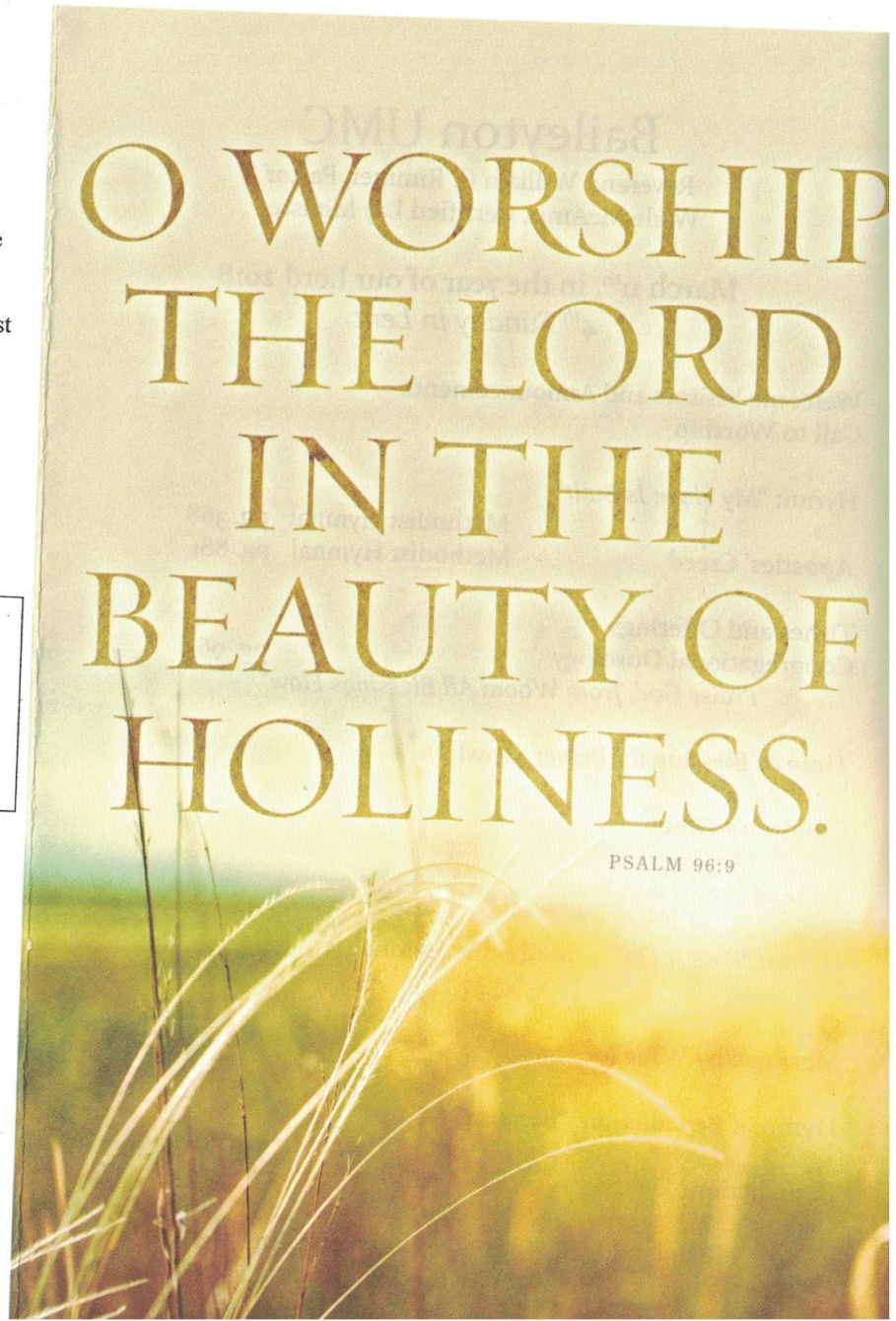
The private replied, "Yeah, sure."
