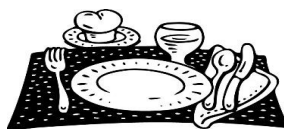

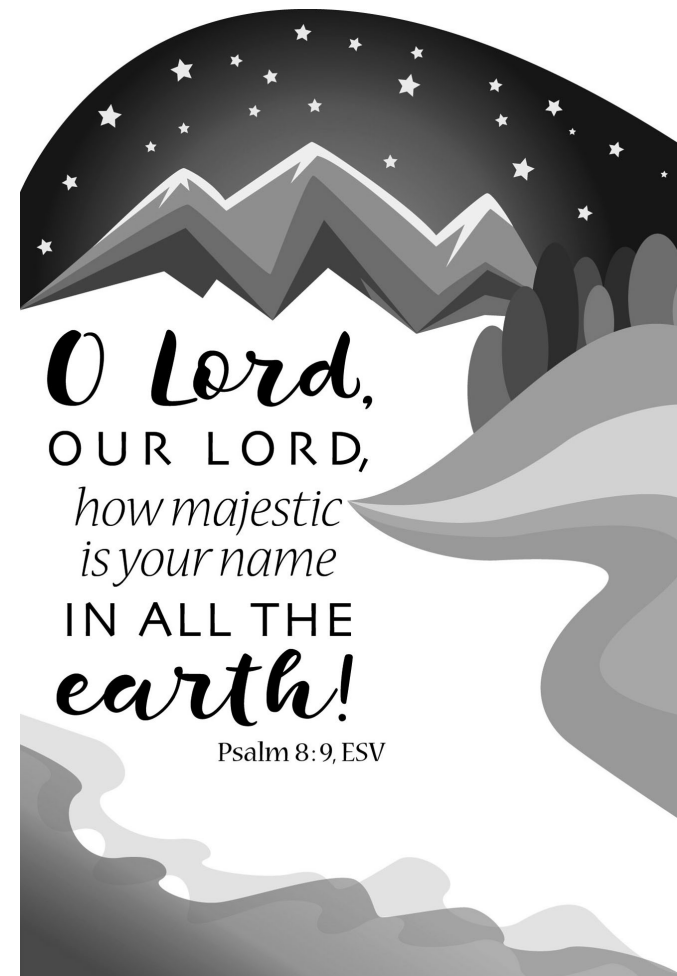

If you like organizing and cleaning out, I have a few projects I could use some assistance in tackling. Times are flexible, just give me a call.

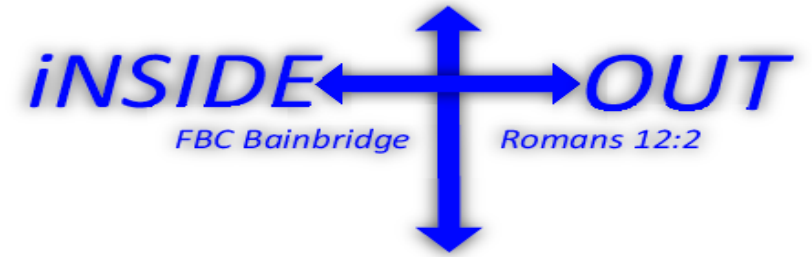
Training Opportunities
