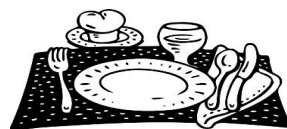

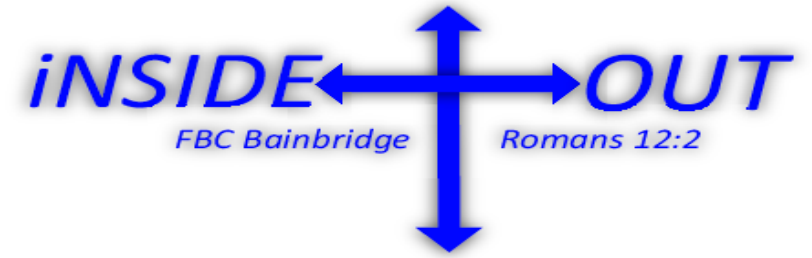
## Training Opportunities
