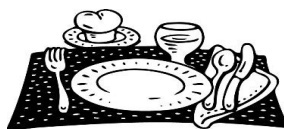

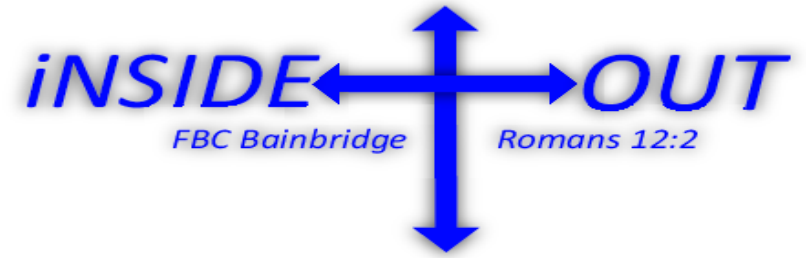
Training Opportunities
