**We once again thank you for your diligence and commitment to keeping our school safe and open, especially as the COVID-19 numbers in our community are increasing. As a reminder, [all parents have agreed to follow these DAILY protocols before arriving at school:](#)**

I will check my child(ren) DAILY for:

- Fever/temperature of 100.0 or greater
- New or worsening cough/shortness of breath
- Diarrhea and/or vomiting
- Fatigue/muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat/congestion

**If your child has any of these symptoms, or anyone in your immediate family is exhibiting symptoms commonly associated with COVID-19, your child should remain at home. If no one in the household has been exposed to a positive COVID-19 case, your child may return to school 24 hours after they or applicable family member no longer has symptoms.**

Thank you for your continued partnership. Please also consider taking an additional step in keeping everyone healthy this winter by getting flu shots for your family. 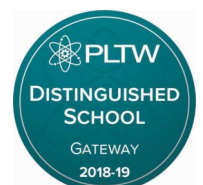
