**COVID-19 Updates—Yesterday, the governor issued a new order limiting indoor public gatherings to 25% capacity. Both our school and parish are exempt from this order, but please know that our focus has not changed.** We continue to be focused on the safety of everyone entering our buildings through sanitizing and creating as much social distance as possible. As we continue to assess safety best practices, we will be extending the COVID no-classroom volunteer policy. The exceptions continue to be daily volunteers for the lunchroom, playground, and health room. We have also made the decision to delay our plan to move the specialty teachers to their classrooms at this time. Music, Art, Library, and Spanish will continue to visit classrooms with their mobile carts. Both policies will be reviewed on November 1st.

**Thank you for continuing to assess your children's health daily. Together we will continue to keep the health and safety of our students and staff a top priority.**
