Holy Apostles Athletics Program Update—The Holy Apostles Athletic Program is wrapping up another successful sports season. The [Athletics Annual Report](#) demonstrates the student athlete involvement as well as the volunteer effort to help operate the program. The Holy Apostles Athletic Board is always looking for additional members to join the team.

It is also time to starting thinking about HA Athletics for the 2019-2020 school year. [Volleyball registration](#) is now open for all incoming 5th, 6th, 7th, and 8th grade school and faith formation students for next year. The early registration deadline is June 24th and the final registration deadline is July 15th (extra \$10 fee will be assessed for registrations received after June 24th). With these deadlines falling over the summer break, we encourage everyone to register early for Volleyball. Basketball and Track registration for the 2019/20 school year is also open with later deadline dates advertised on the website.

This Saturday is the final 5th through 8th grade track meet of the year - the Metro Milwaukee Metro Invitational at Quad Park / Marquette University High School. Please come out to cheer on our HA student athletes as they wrap up another successful track season. Thank you to all the coaches who have dedicated time and effort to teach the kids at practices and got them ready to perform at the meets.

HA track awards night will be next Tuesday May 28th from 6:00 to 8:00 in the gym, and uniform turn-in will take place beforehand at 5:30 to 6:00 in the gym. If you cannot make this evening, please get your child's track uniform to another family to turn in or bring it to the office in a bag with your child's name and grade.

Record Breaking News! There is a list of the all time track records hanging in the HA gym, and it is not often that someone breaks one of those records. We have had a record broken in each of the last two meets!

Holy Apostles Meet: Reenie Ganzer broke the School Record for Girls Discus with a throw of 70' 4", breaking the previous record of 68' 7" set by Alyssa Kraninger in 2017.

Greater Waukesha Meet: Evelyn Mattioli broke the 5th grade girls record in the 400 with a time of 1:13.94, breaking the previous record of 1:14.19 set by Marissa Nennig in 2005!
