We are looking forward to bringing the community together to get to know each other and to grow in faith. Look for more details in the next few weeks.

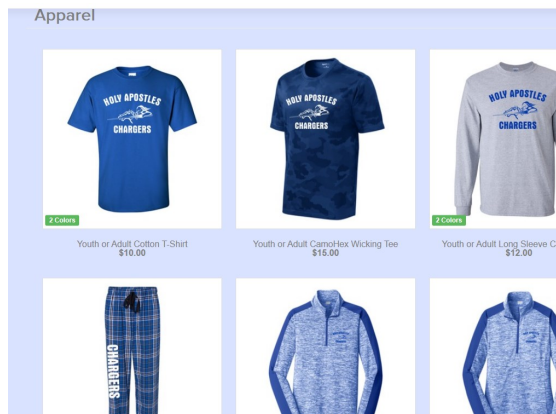
