We were excited to welcome all our students back into the building full time. We know pick up and drop off is taking longer than it has in the past and know there has been a back up onto National Ave. This is partly due to more families choosing to drive their children vs. using the bus. We hope to gain efficiencies as we all get faster and more experienced. Please know that we are continually evaluating these procedures. Our goal is to keep our students as safe as possible while improving time efficiencies. Thank you for your patience while we learn together. Please watch future Messengers for process updates.

- **Please DO NOT drop off your child before 8:05am.** If you arrive early, please have your child wait in your car until the door opens. Review drop off procedures under Quick Links (to the right). **Please note: the west lot is reserved for PreK drop off only.**
- **Afternoon Parent Pick up: All students (including PreK) will exit through the North School door/car line.** We will be modifying our classroom dismissal timing to limit hallway congestion.
- **During pick up and drop off, please pull all the way down the line.** The first car should be near the cone by the school office. Also, please do not park on the surrounding side streets to pick up or drop off your children.

School photos will be going home with students today. Please check their backpacks. Picture retake day will be September 30th.

Our 8th grade Commissioning Mass is scheduled for Friday, September 11th at 8:30am. We are looking forward to seeing the Class of 2021 accept their leadership role in our school! 8th grade parents, guests, and parishioners are encouraged to attend and should sit in the west side of the church (nearest to the parking lot). 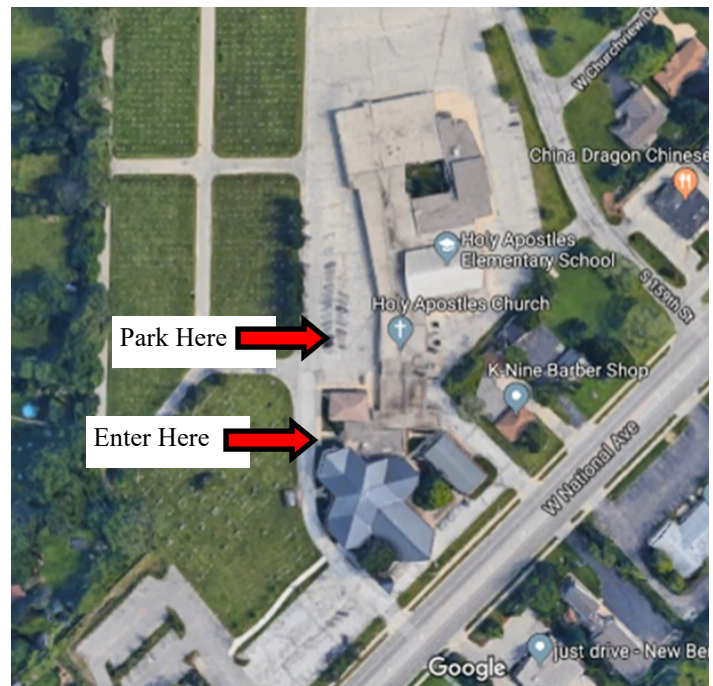

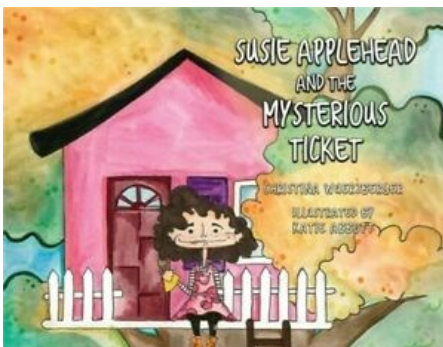
