Dear Seniors and Parents,

The men participating in the Good Shepherd Men's Fishing Trip last month have generously pledged money towards establishing a scholarship fund for graduating high school seniors of the Good Shepherd parish. They have asked the Youth Committee of the parish to establish and award these scholarships. To that end, we plan to award two \$1000 scholarships to graduating seniors who have been active in the parish and youth activities, and who exemplify a model of community service.

Included in this packet are the full eligibility criteria and the application form.

To be considered for the scholarship you must: 1) complete an application form, and 2) provide a one page essay. These must be **RECEIVED** by the church office by **4:30pm, Friday, May 23, 2008. Please mark them to my attention. Late submittals will not be accepted or considered.**

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Senior Scholarship Guidelines

The Youth Ministry of the Episcopal Church of the Good Shepherd, as represented by members of the Youth Committee, has been charged with awarding (a) scholarship(s) to (a) graduating senior(s) from the Good Shepherd Community who:

1. Is or is the child of a member of the Good Shepherd Parish, and
2. Is involved in one or more Good Shepherd Youth Ministry programs including but not limited to:
 - a. Acolytes
 - b. Sunday School
 - c. EYC
 - d. Mission Trips and Retreats, and
3. Exemplifies a model of community service within or outside the Good Shepherd Parish

The Youth Committee may also consider, but does not solely need to base the decision on financial need.

Any Youth Committee member must remove themselves from the award process completely if their child applies for the scholarship.
