Youth Ministry Beyond Sunday Nights

Where does the church “go” when you leave the church? How does a teenager make the connection between faith and life? In the midst of busy days, homework, friends, part time jobs, soccer practice, band practice, a school dance, a bout of depression, a fight with a parent, lost locker combination, a failing grade, a standardized test...how does a young person encounter Christ?

Participants in this event will explore a young person's life OUTSIDE of the church- all the while seeking how to be the church in that outside life! Using current research on the “Lives of Protestant Youth”, spiritual practices, small group conversations, and a variety of interactive experiences those involved in this event will explore, with a community of fellow youth accompaniers, what it means to be in God's Space as a young person and how youth leaders can begin to identify a new way to see youth ministry.
