Camp Pee Dee is owned and operated by the Presbytery of New Harmony of the Presbyterian (USA) Church as a year-round camp and retreat center. It offers a variety of camping experiences for children of all ages during the summer to grow closer to God while living in His creation.

B.L.A.S.T. "Bible Learning & Sharing Time"

Daily campers will have a B.L.A.S.T session led by BLAST leaders: church professionals and leaders. This time will allow for study of scripture, music, activities, and questions to foster our campers to grow together as young Christians. These lessons will revolve around our summer theme "Handle with Care" as campers learn about God's creation and our role within it!

The Staff

CPD is run by a full-time staff. A camp Director, Facilities Director, Equestrian Coordinator, and Maintenance staff are on campus year-round. Seasonal staff is hired to run camping programs in the summer. All staff undergo a rigorous SLED background check and hiring process. Extensive training programs are also required to become a CPD Staffer, prior to summer programs, counselors and support staff complete a 7-10 day training session. All staff are certified in CPR and First Aid and many hold a lifeguard certification, as well.
