

POSITION DESCRIPTION FOR: Horseback Riding Instructor

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this position is to carry out the work of Camp Pee Dee's Camping Division of the Presbytery of New Harmony, PC (USA), by planning and implementing programs for the Summer Horseback Riding Camps

QUALIFICATIONS:

This person must be at least 20 years of age and have skills in working with children, youth, and adults in a camp environment. This person must have documented horseback riding experience, the ability to supervise others, be CPR/First Aid certified, and be patient, friendly, and sensitive.

ACCOUNTABILITY:

The person in this position shall be accountable to the Camp Pee Dee Director and the Camping Division of the Presbytery of New Harmony.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

***SAFETY IS OUR #1 PRIORITY ***

1. Supervise all Horseback riding programming at camp.
 2. Work with the Camp Pee Dee Staff and the Camping Division of the Presbytery of New Harmony in development, implementation, and expansion of horseback riding programs.
 3. Orient horses to the camp setting (barn and riding corral).
 4. Provide a caring, nurturing, and safe environment for the children.
 5. Develop and post barn rules.
 6. Care for and feed horses; clean barn, stalls, and tack as needed.
 7. Orient camp staff on safe riding and handling of horses.
 8. Patiently teach campers horsemanship (brushing, washing, saddling, leading, and riding).
 9. Provide a spiritual model for the campers and staff that participate in the Camp Pee Dee programs.
 10. Provide weekend and after hours coverage as needed.
- Accept extensions of duty and responsibilities as assigned.
