A mentor is someone who has a deep love for Christ and for others. You want the girls you mentor to give their best to God, which will not likely happen unless you do the same. With that, the following will be expected of you:

- ✓ Attend all *Girls 4 God* events.
- ✓ Be on time to all *Girls 4 God* events.
- ✓ Pray for yourself, for the girls, and for your time together before arriving at each event.
- ✓ Reach out to your girls beyond scheduled events via email and phone
- ✓ Use positive, encouraging language.
- ✓ Use the events to focus on your girls. Don't talk about your problems!
- ✓ Use your best judgment in deciding what you will share with them.
- ✓ You lead your group and model for them the four main purposes of a small group: Prayer (1 Thess 5:17; Phil 4:6-7), Transformation (Rom 12:2, 2 Cor 3:18), Fellowship (Acts 2), and Service (Mark 9:35).
- ✓ Dress appropriately. When you walk out the door you should be wearing an outfit your parents would approve of. If you arrive at an event dressed questionably, you will be asked to go home and change.
- ✓ And most importantly, desire to serve Christ by being a positive role model so they may see an alternative to living a worldly life, a life completely surrendered to Christ!!

As a mentor, your mentee(s) will be watching everything you say and do in your time together. You are setting the bar for them and you'll want to set it high. Following these expectations will help to ensure that you are making a positive influence in the lives of your girls, and ultimately a difference for His kingdom!
