What a mighty God we serve, and as we have been commissioned not to make converts but disciples we leave no stone unturned with all determination to make every one who comes through our doors seasoned disciples for Jesus Christ. There is now preparation for Baptism at the end of this month January, and already plans are underway to hold a fund raising service in March for the purchase of land in order to build a big enough place to accommodate the rising number of people attending our services. Please join with us in prayers for more converts to be turned into Disciples of Jesus Christ. Preaching the sermon, Rev. Samuel A.K. Dunya challenge the people to hold fast to the faith, and be determined to see their friends, families and neighbourhood reach with the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. His interpreter was Rev. Dunya graduated from GlobeServe College of Missions in 1997 and since been in charge of the GlobeServe branch church in Akim Oda.
