## **What is Mission Ghana?**

Mission Ghana is a chance to serve God and the people of Central West Africa while experiencing a culture and people completely different than that of the United States.

## **Where do we go and what do we do?**

Missionaries travel to Ho, Ghana and work with our partner Pastor Sam Dunya and GlobeServe Ministries to share the love of God and serve through a variety of projects, including medical clinics (malaria education) and general health education and farming. We may also conduct a Leadership training and development course that is designed for women, as well as pastors and leaders who want to empower women.

## **Who can go?**

Anyone with a heart for Jesus and 18 years of age or older.

## **Where do we stay?**

Missionaries stay in a western-style hotel with restaurant, pool, private baths and air-conditioning.

## **What travel documents do I need?**

A current U.S. passport is required as well as a Visa into Ghana. Information on acquiring a Visa will be provided by the Missions staff after registration.

## **What immunizations do I need?**

Yellow fever vaccination is required for entry into Ghana. Other recommended vaccinations will be discussed at the training meetings.

## **What is the cost?**

Cost is estimated to be \$2,500 (depending on airfare). This cost includes airfare, hotel, all breakfasts at the hotel, ground transportation, and bottled water during the trip. Vaccinations are an additional cost.
