What is Mission Robin's Nest?

It is a short-term mission experience serving youth at Robin's Nest Children's Home. Robin's Nest is a place of healing as many of the children have experienced malnourishment, neglect and abuse in their past.

How do we get to Robin's Nest?

Members of the mission team fly into Montego Bay, Jamaica. They will be met at the airport by representatives from Robin's Nest and transported by van 45 minutes north to "The Nest."

What projects will we do at Robin's Nest?

Volunteers with a heart for serving children will serve in various capacities, including:

- Assisting pod parents with cleaning and chores
- Light construction projects in need of: painters, carpenters, plumbers, masons, electricians, auto mechanics, gardeners/landscapers and other "handy people"
- Working with physically challenged children (in need of occupational therapists, physical therapists, speech therapists, and others trained in specialized or medical fields)

What is the cost?

Estimated cost is \$800-\$1,000 but may vary depending on airfare. The total cost covers airfare, food, lodging and insurance. Additional money will be needed for meals in the airports and souvenirs.

Who can go?

A maximum of 10 can be housed at "The Nest." Minimum age for participants is 14 years old.

Where do we stay?

A large one-bedroom apartment can accommodate a small team (8 people of same gender or family members). Larger teams will be housed at the school down the hill from "The Nest."

How do I register?

You can register on-line at www.hopewdm.org/missions. Or you can print a registration form online, complete it and turn it in at the front office. The \$150.00 non-refundable payment is due upon registration. Registration forms can also be found at the Mission Center.
