

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
HIGH POINT FELLOWSHIP, A CHURCH OF CHRIST  
A TEXAS NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

The undersigned, a natural person of the age of eighteen (18) years or more acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Texas Non-profit Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

**ARTICLE ONE**

NAME

The name of the Corporation is High Point Fellowship, A Church of Christ.

**ARTICLE TWO**

NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

The Corporation is a non-profit corporation.

**ARTICLE THREE**

DURATION

The period of its duration is perpetual.

**ARTICLE FOUR**

PURPOSE

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, and educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

4.01. The Corporation is organized and operated primarily for the purpose of engaging in religious worship and promoting the spiritual development or well-being of individuals. The primary purpose of the Corporation, subject to the limitations herein provided, is to conduct such business as permitted a church that is a non-profit corporation under the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act.

4.02. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in this Article Four. No substantial part of the activities of the

Corporation, as a corporate entity, shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

4.03. This Corporation is formed for the purpose of the promotion and support of Christian worship for glorifying God and conforming to the Holy Bible, and the transactions of such secular business for the maintenance of said association for such religious purposes. It being understood that the basic fundamental principles of the Corporation and the Christian worship to be conducted in connection therewith, shall, in all respects, conform to the teachings and examples contained in the Holy Bible. One objective of the association is to increase the number of members for the benefit of the community and for the glory of God. This Corporation is independent and not controlled or under the authority of any other human organization.

## **ARTICLE FIVE**

### **DISSOLUTION**

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the District Court of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

## **ARTICLE SIX**

### **MEMBERS**

The Corporation shall have one or more classes of members as provided in its bylaws. The management of its affairs is vested in its board of directors pursuant to Article 1396-2.14 of the Texas Revised Civil Statutes.

## **ARTICLE SEVEN**

### **AGENT FOR PROCESS**

The street address of the Corporation's initial registered office is: 13441 Lime Creek Road, Cedar Park, Williamson County, Texas. The name of the Corporation's initial registered agent at such address is Larry B. Baird.

**ARTICLE EIGHT**

**DIRECTORS**

The number of Directors constituting the Corporation's initial Board of Directors is three (3) and shall serve as directors until their successor or successors have been selected by majority election of the members of the Corporation. The names and addresses of the initial directors are:

**ARTICLE NINE**

**EXEMPTION OF DIRECTORS FROM LIABILITY**

A Director of the Corporation shall not be personally liable to the Corporation for monetary damages for an act or omission in the Director's capacity as a Director, except to the extent that any applicable law may prevent such Director from being relieved of such personal liability. Any repeal or modification of this Article shall be prospective only and shall not adversely affect any limitation of the personal liability of a director of the Corporation existing at the time of such repeal or modification.

**ARTICLE TEN**

**INDEMNIFICATION**

The Corporation may indemnify a person who was, is or is threatened to be made a named defendant or respondent in litigation or other proceedings because the person is or was a director or other person related to the Corporation to the extent provided by law governing indemnification. As provided by the bylaws, the Board of Directors shall have the power to define the requirements and limitations for the Corporation to indemnify directors, officers or others related to the Corporation.
