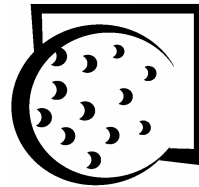

Mosquito Bites

Besides the fact that mosquito bites itch like crazy, there's a slight chance that you could catch West Nile Virus. (How to prevent them:)
Get rid of any standing water or overgrown weeds around your home, where mosquitoes congregate. Cover up as much of your body as you can stand. Use an insect repellent with DEET. Adults should use one with 30% DEET on the label; children between six months and 12 years should only use one with 10%. If they're younger than 2, only put the repellent on them once a day, and 3 times a day if they are under 12. Don't ever put it on the face or hands. If you get bitten: Put on some calamine lotion or just add enough water to baking soda to make a paste, and slather it on. If you are not feeling well several days later, check with your doctor to see if you have an infection.
