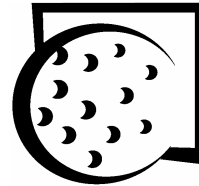

Cool Refreshing Water

If you use a water bottle this summer, wash it
regularly with soap and water. Soft plastic bot-
tles tend to bend which may create tiny crevices
in the plastic where bacteria can flourish. Rapid
bacterial growth is less likely in hard plastic bot-
tles. However, bacteria can enter and grow in
any bottle. Especially when the bottle is used
repeatedly without washing it or if the water
becomes warm.
